

## Results of the Internal Letter of Comment, June 2013

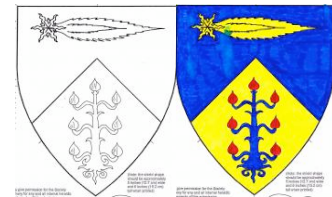
Unto Dorcas, Gold Falcon and the learned members of the Calontir College of Heraldry does Brigida, Saker herald send her greetings.

Here are the results of the deliberations of the Commenting Herald during the months of May on the most recent Internal Letter of Intent. All items forwarded on to Laurel were sent out on the 28 June 2013 ELoI. Items not sent on to Laurel appear at the end of this letter on page 4.

### **Forwarded on to Laurel:**

#### **1: Alson Nonne - New Name & New Device**

*Per chevron azure and Or, a comet fesswise Or and a crequier azure leaved gules.*



Submitter desires a feminine name.  
Sound most important.

Alson - documented to the 16th century via IGI Parish Extracts. There are many examples including:

- Alson Adam Female Christening 10 June 1581 Phillack, Cornwall, England BENNTT ADAM Batch: C023192
- Alson Allen Female Christening 11 Februray 1549 Parkham, Devon, England JOHN ALLEN Batch: P001801
- Alson Frynde Female Christening 10 March 1576 Tawton, Devon, England JOHN FRYNDE Batch: C052351
- Alson Veyle Female Christening 15 August 1573 Saint Mabyn, Cornwall, England JOHN VEYLE Batch: P002051

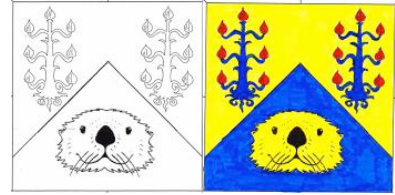
Nonne - documented to the 16th century via the IGI Parish Extracts. There are many examples including:

**2: Alson Nonne** - New Badge

*Per chevron azure and Or, two crequiers azure leaved gules and an otter's head cabossed Or.*



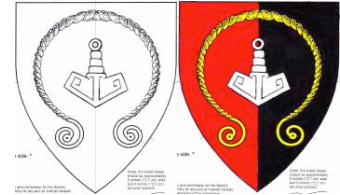
**3: Arne Sørensen** - New Name & New Device

*Per pale gules and sable, within a torc Or a Thor's hammer argent.*

Submitter desires a masculine name.

Language (Norse/Scandinavian region) most important.

Culture (Norse/Scandinavian region) most important.



Originally submitted as Arnórr Sørensen on the 2013-02-08 Calontir Calon ILoI, it was returned at Kingdom level.

Arne - Old Swedish male given name found in *Sveriges Medltida Personnamn* as a header spelling. In the information provided by clicking on the link (copies were included), the spelling *Arne* is noted as the Nom. form dated to 1341. The spelling *Arne(s)* is noted as the Gen. form dated to 1455. The spelling *Arne* is noted as the Dat. form dated to 1530. Examples of the names listed include: 1345 Arne Gefvalldzson, 1348 Arne a Bakka, 1402 Arne Bæinsson, 1425 Arne Olafson, 1502 Arne Biørnson & 1522 Arne Matssen.

Sørensen - Old Swedish patronymic. This gentle is the real world son of the gentle known in the SCA as Søren atte Raven. He wishes to utilize a surname that reflects his relationship to his father. Søren's name was registered on the June 2009 LoAR (via Calontir).

**4: Crespin de Laon** - New Name

Submitter desires a masculine name.

No major changes.

Language (13th-14th century French) most important.

Culture (13th-14th century French) most important.

**5: Hadassah filla de Solomó** - New Name

Submitter desires a feminine name.

No major changes.

Language (1400's Spain) most important.

Culture (Jewish female) most important.

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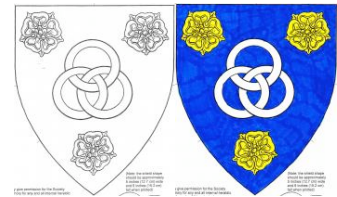

### 6: Inga in danska - New Device

OSCAR finds the name registered exactly as it appears in June of 2008, via Calontir

*Azure, three annulets interlaced, one and two, argent between three roses Or.*

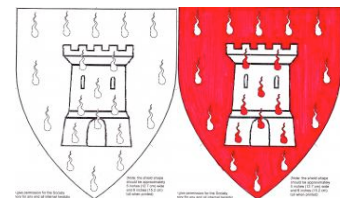


Please note: On the Kingdom letter dated 8 May 2013, the submitter had a name submission (Inge inn danski) along with this device submission. After it was posted in OSCAR, it was found that she had already registered Inga in danska in June 2008 via Calontir. The name submission was withdrawn before the ELoI was issued. ### 7: Miklos Farma - Resub Device Change

OSCAR finds the name registered exactly as it appears in April of 2012, via Calontir

*Gules, a tower argent goutty de sang, an orle of gouttes d'eau.*



Old Item: *Per pale argent and Or, an ypotrill rampant to sinister within a bordure vert*, to be retained as a badge.

His previous submission *Gules, a tower argent goutty de sang, an orle of gouttes d'eau* was returned by Laurel on the 4/2012 LoAR for a redraw. The apostrophe style of gouttes were used which are not registerable without period evidence. The client was cautioned to make fewer but larger gouttes. 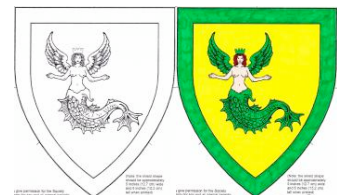
His current device, *Per pale argent and Or, an ypotrill rampant to sinister within a bordure vert*, was registered under the name Manfred de Outremer via the Outlands in 03/1987.

On the same 4/2012 LoAR his primary name was changed from Manfred de Outremer to Miklos Farma.

### 8: Morgana of Raglan - New Device Change

OSCAR finds the name registered exactly as it appears in November of 1989, via Calontir

*Or, a winged mermaid proper, crined gules, wings displayed, crowned of a county coronet, a bordure vert.*



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Old Item: *Per bend sinister vert and Or, two melusines counterchanged*, to be retained as a badge.

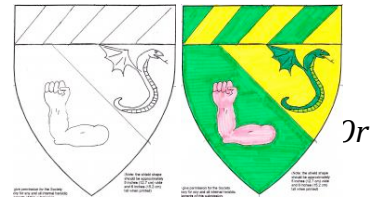
This gentle was given a County on 19 September 1992 via Calontir.

Her previous device, *Per bend sinister vert and Or, two melusines counterchanged* was registered 11/1989 via Calontir.

### **Returned for Additional Work:**

#### **1: Hadassah filla de Solomó - New Device**

Unfortunately this needs to be returned for more work. The device *Per bend Or and vert, a pithon contourny vert and an arm embowed bendwise sinister proper, a chief bendy sinister vert and* was submitted with an incorrectly divided field. From the September 2009 LoAR: "The per bend line should bisect the portion of the field which shows beneath the chief. The chiefmost point on the per bend line should be where the bottom of the chief meets the dexter side of the shield." A suggested redraw should be something like:



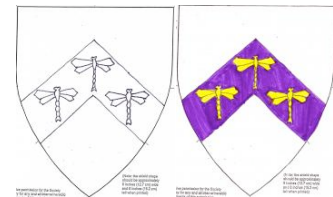
#### **2: Rodrigo Hernández de Castilla - New Name**

Unfortunately this needs to be returned for more work. The name implies that he is the son of King Fernando of Castile; Hernandez is the patronymic form of Fernando. The easiest changes would be to either fix the patronymic or the locative.

### **Pended Submission:**

#### **1: Rodrigo Hernández de Castilla - New Device**
